- Allow all players, no matter their level of ability, the opportunity to play (Youth Only)
- Respect the rights, dignity & worth of every player and treat everyone equally
- Always pursue fair play
- Ensure that the correct procedure has been followed in the signing of players to the squad
- Encourage the good behaviour of all squad players throughout their time with the club
- Prohibit use of camcorders and cameras unless consent received from opposition and referee
- Be aware of the SFA's and the Club's Child & Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy and Procedures
- Ensure that coaching sessions are enjoyable, well-structured and focus on developing skills, decision-making and general understanding of the game
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with players based on mutual trust and respect
- Encourage players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Accept the referee decisions and only complain about these decisions through the proper procedure
- Know where to find appropriate first-aid

NAMF:

- Discourage all forms of bullying, violence, racial abuse and abusive language
- Do not use Social Media to comment on team or club matters
- Not allow alcohol to be consumed or be present at any game or training days
